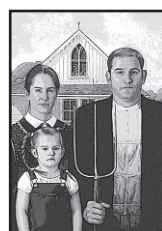

Stone Terrace Village will consist of facilities for seniors only in a variety of buildings. Going from west closest to Delaware Street to east along I-65 there will be a complex of interconnected buildings including: a long single story building that will offer an activity center; medical examining rooms, administrative office and other common

areas; a three-story building for assisted living and memory-care, with a dining hall; and a two-story skilled-nursing facility that also connects to a single-story skilled-nursing memory-care building on the north. Across a private road to the east will be a four-story independent living building.

Jeff Ban, an engineer representing the developer, told the commissioners that the taller building will also act

as a buffer from the noise of I-65. New to the plans are an extensive stocked pond that will eventually have a private fishing pier for the residents' use. That pond has been incorporated into the property's drainage design.

Ban described the drainage system as being able to relieve storm drainage woes that have been experienced in the area on both sides of Delaware Street.

City Councilman Bill Feder, D-1st,

expressed concerned about the population density being in excess of the city's multi-family limit.

Director of Community Development Curt Graves responded that Stone Terrace has a special-use variance as a healthcare community.

"It is no different than Saint Anthony or Wittenburg," he said, referring to the local nursing home and senior residential community.
